	8000 linear feet or more	\$550.00 plus \$232.00 for each 8000 linear feet; or fraction thereof

C For each renovation project involving the removal or stripping of pipe where the outside diameter of piping insulation (wrapping) is greater than 2.35 inches the fees are assessed as follows:	$A = \frac{3.14159 \times L \times D}{12}$ <p>Where: A = Area in square feet L = Linear length of piping in feet D = Outside diameter of pipe insulation (wrap) in inches</p>	Such projects shall be evaluated in terms of square footage and assessed the fee per section A of this table.
