


### PARTICULATE MATTER PM




Particulate matter PM10 and fine Particulate Matter PM2.5 comes from power plants, dust, construction sites, wildfires, cars and manufacturing facilities.

Coal or oil burning power plants and industries, refineries, and diesel engines.




#### NITROGEN DIOXIDE NO2



Portable generators, charcoal grills, clothes dryers, fireplaces, ovens, furnaces, vehicles running in garages.

Ozone (smog): when gases or vapors created by cars, solvents, factories, and pesticides mix and react in the presence of sunlight

#### LEAD PB

Lead smelters, ore and metals processing, engine aircraft operating on leaded aviation fuel, waste incinerators, utilities, and lead-acid battery manufacturing plants.
